 - Art Night - \$200

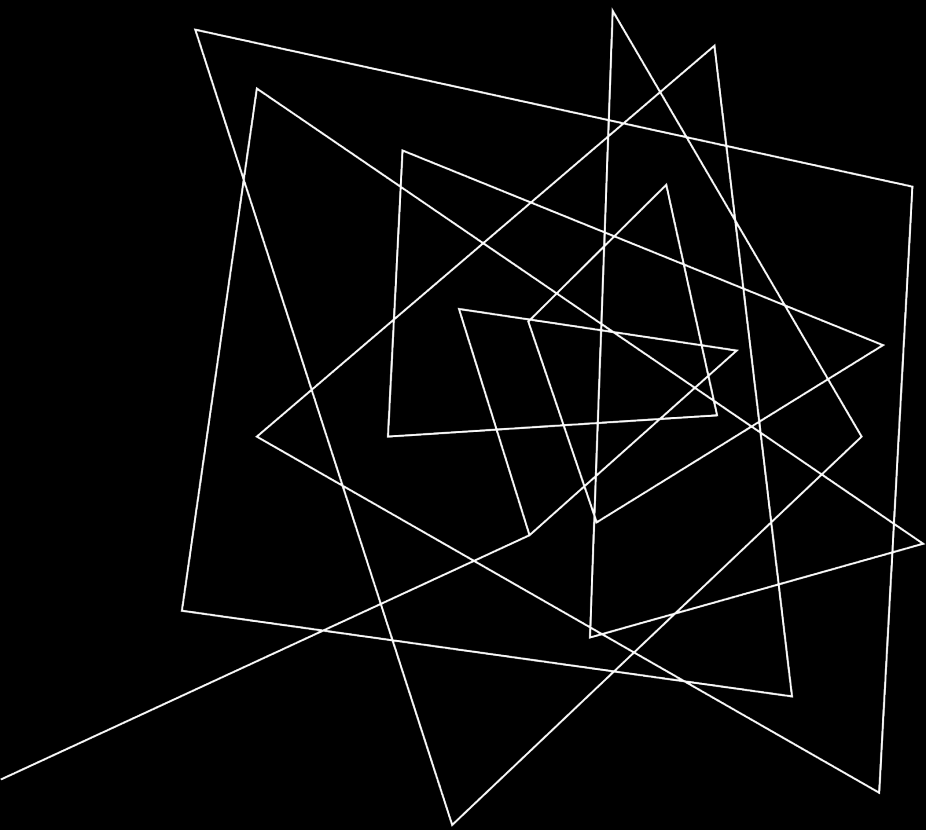

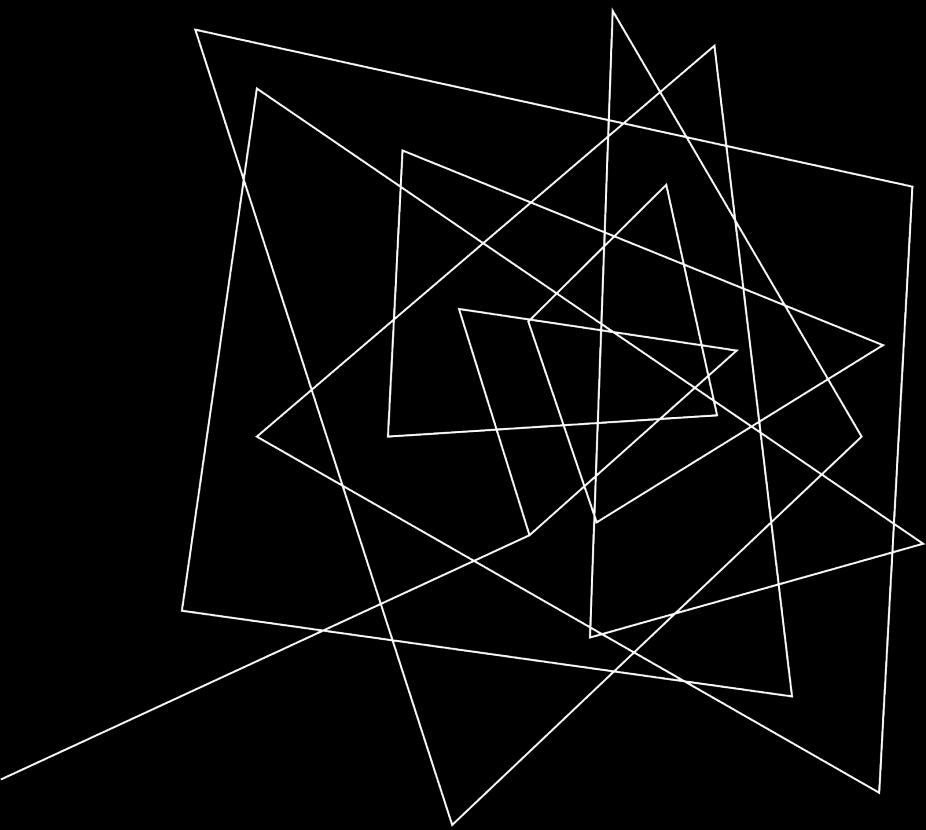


Volunteer Committee Update
