



Bryant Chess Club Codes of Conduct for Students and Parents

STUDENTS should...

- **Remember the Bryant Way:**
We take care of ourselves, we take care of each other, we take care of our school.
- Treat each other, coaches, assistant coaches, and parent volunteers with respect. Pay attention to the chess instruction, and take care to not distract anyone from their roles at Chess Club.
- Check with the parent volunteer, coach, or assistant coach before leaving the room.
- Keep the noise level to a minimum. *Teachers generously allow the Chess Club to use their classrooms, and are often still using them as Chess Club is meeting. Respect their need to work in a calm environment.*
- Treat the equipment with respect. Players should set up their own pieces before they begin play and make sure that all sets are complete before they bag their own pieces at the end.
- Respect the Chess Club areas. Leave the room way you found it. Tables and chairs should be returned to their homes, and other students' belongings should be left undisturbed.
- Never yell out, argue with your opponent, or accuse them of cheating. The proper way to handle a dispute is to raise your hand and discuss the disagreement with the coach, assistant coach or parent volunteer.

PARENTS should...

- Make sure your students make it to sessions immediately after school on Thursdays and are picked up by 4:45 p.m. If you are consistently late picking up your child, we will have to ask you to withdraw your student's membership and participation in the club.
- Volunteer to supervise Thursday Chess Club sessions (in your student's group or another group) at least 2 times per child throughout the year. We need parents in the room to keep players focused and respectful of each other.
- Communicate with Chess Club organizers if you have concerns about coaching, grouping, or the general administration of the sessions.
