Dr. Marshall Principal Update

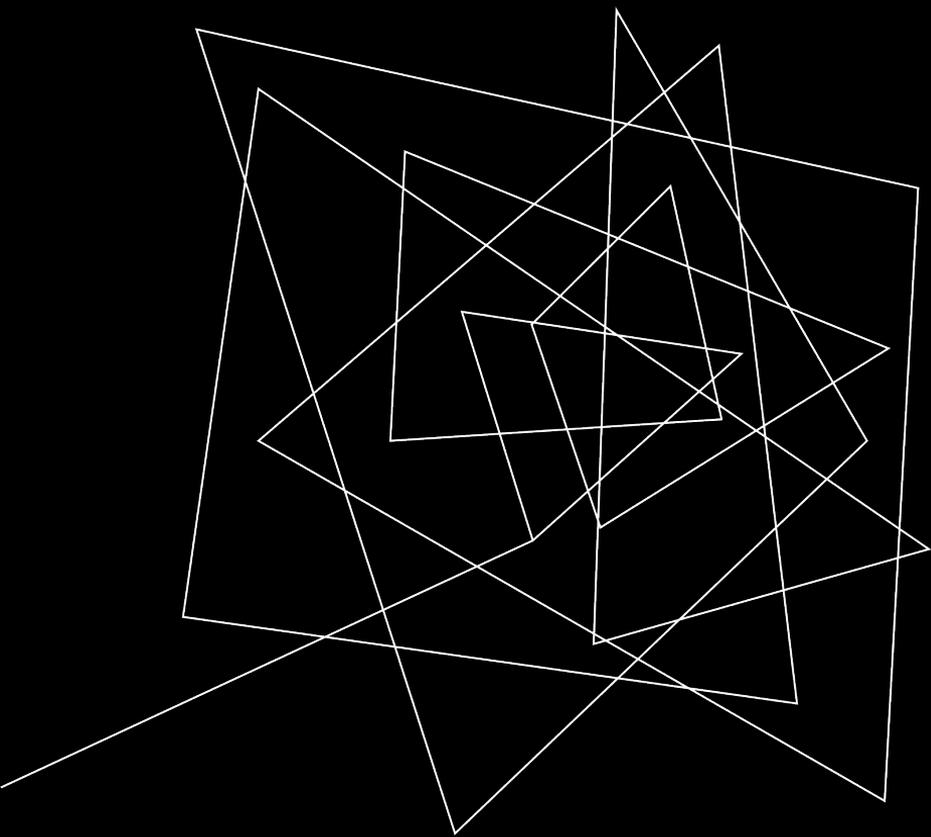
- Working on enrollment numbers - worst case scenario with a low enrollment would be losing 1 staff position, lost of AP, and .5 of a specialist position

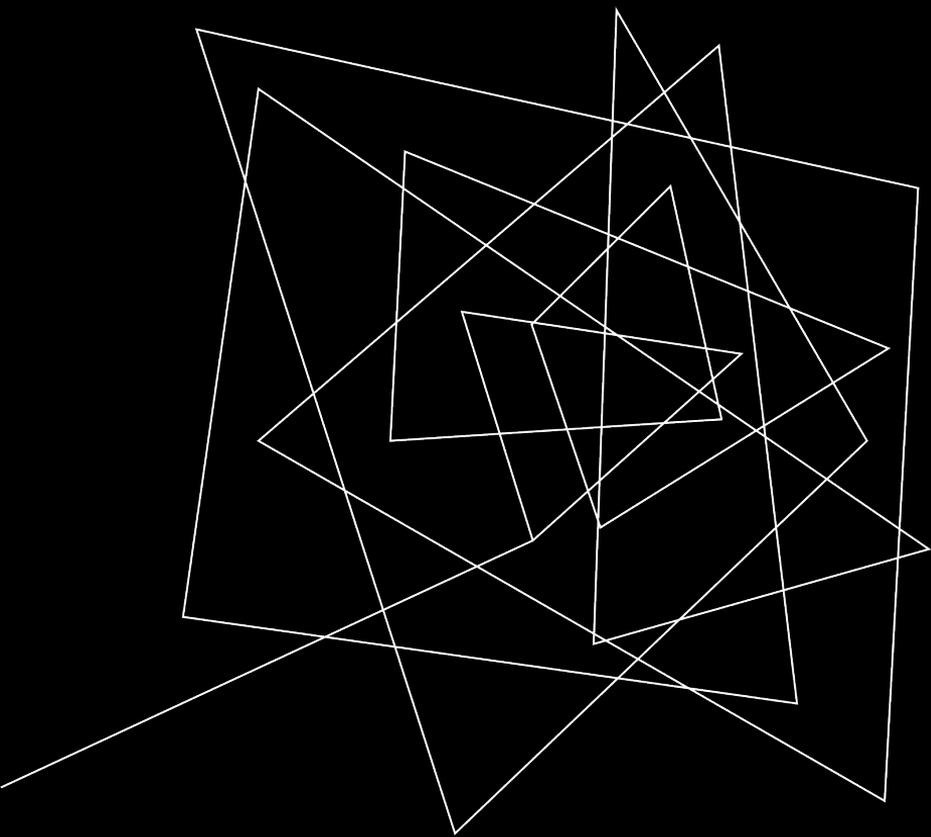


Treasurers Update

- **Budget committee formation - coming up in March/April**



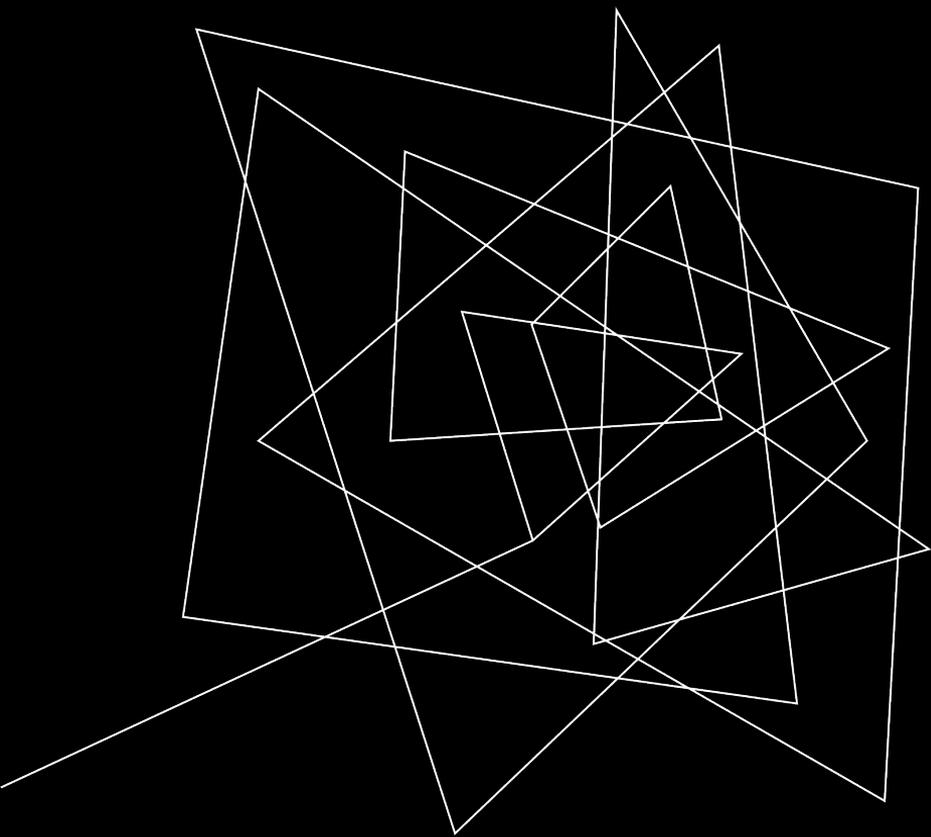


Legislative Updates:

- **Good news:** Legislature continues moving on exempting school districts from new taxes: HB 2257 made it out of fiscal committee before cut-off!
 - Note: The bill would exclude presentations given by nonprofit organizations, like PTAs, from the definition of live presentations
- **Not great news but expected:** School funding bills (like SB 5918 re. MSOC funding) largely didn't make it out of finance committees - there is still hope there will be funding provided in the budget though.
- **New tax ideas still moving** including millionaires tax: Superintendent Reykdal asking that \$861 annually go to K-12 education.
- **Feb 17: Stay tuned for house of origin cutoff**

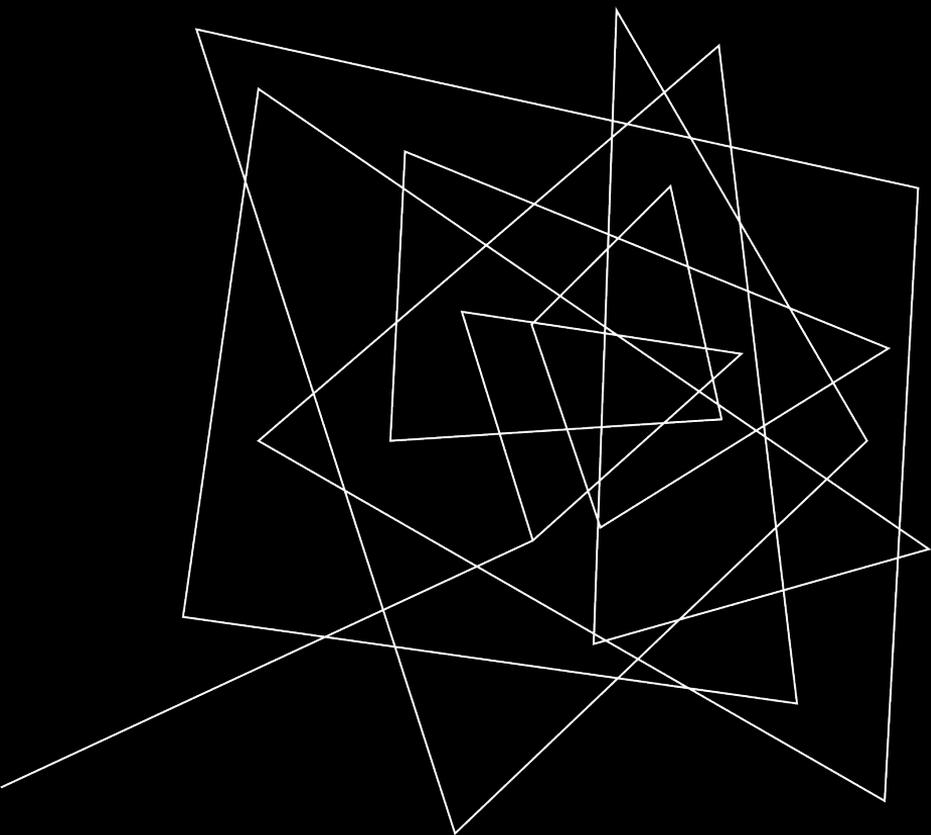

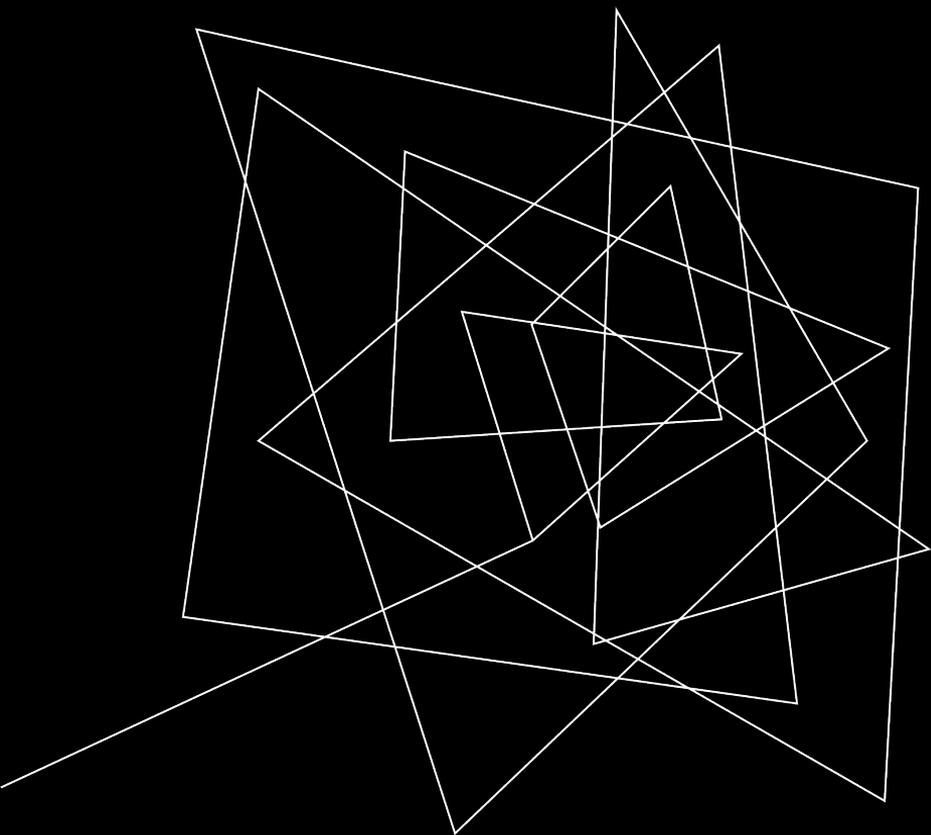
