We seek to inspire our members to take action to support native organizations in our community.

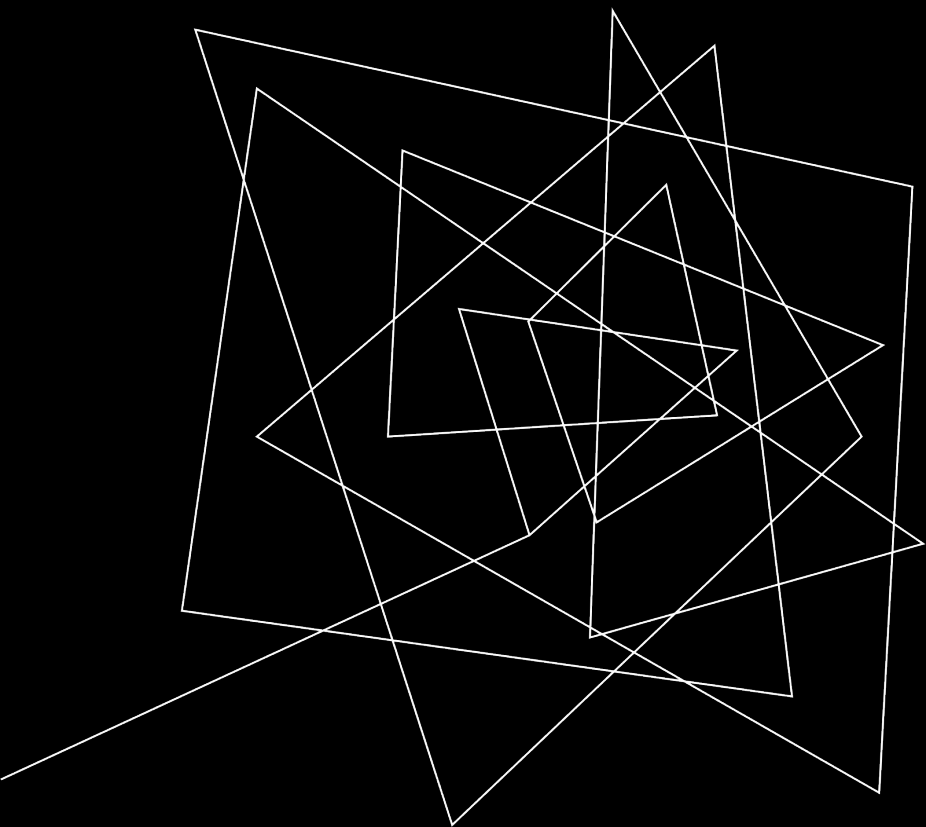

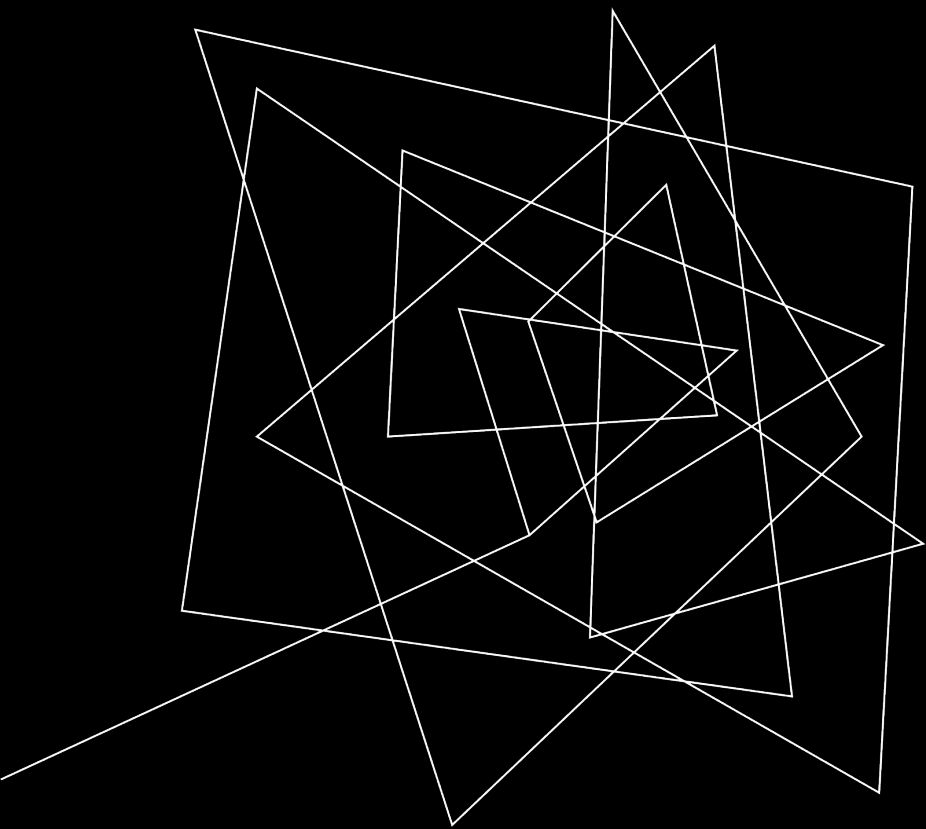
Bryant Mission:

We envision a school in which staff...

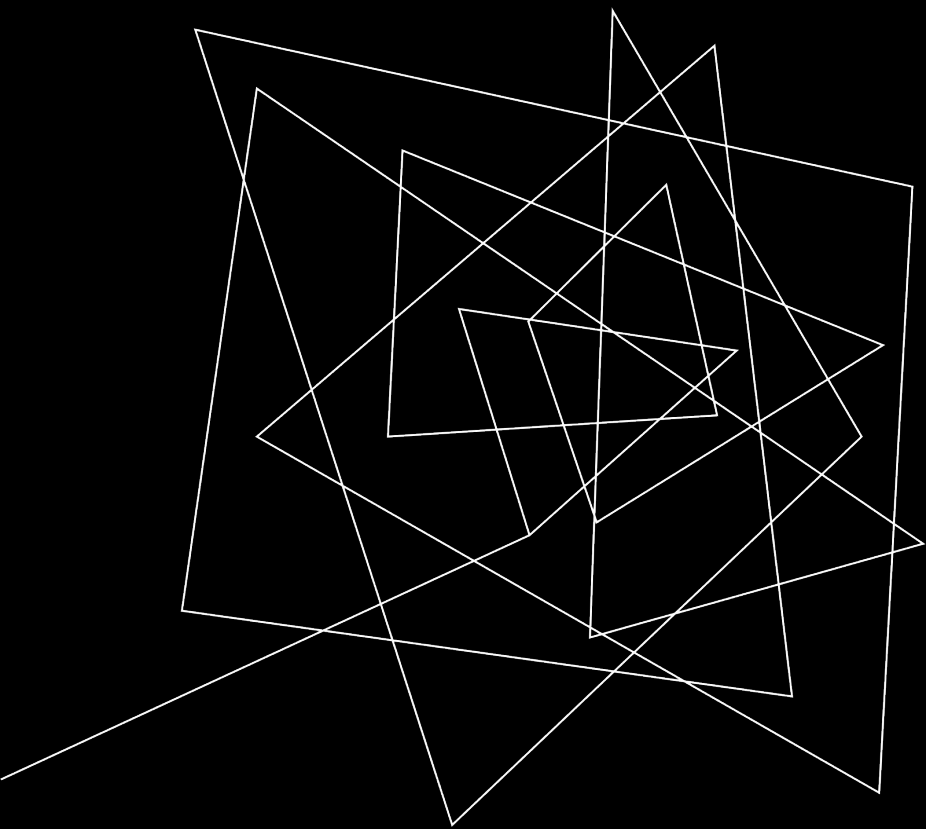
- Collaborate and build connections with colleagues, students and families.

Budget committee updates

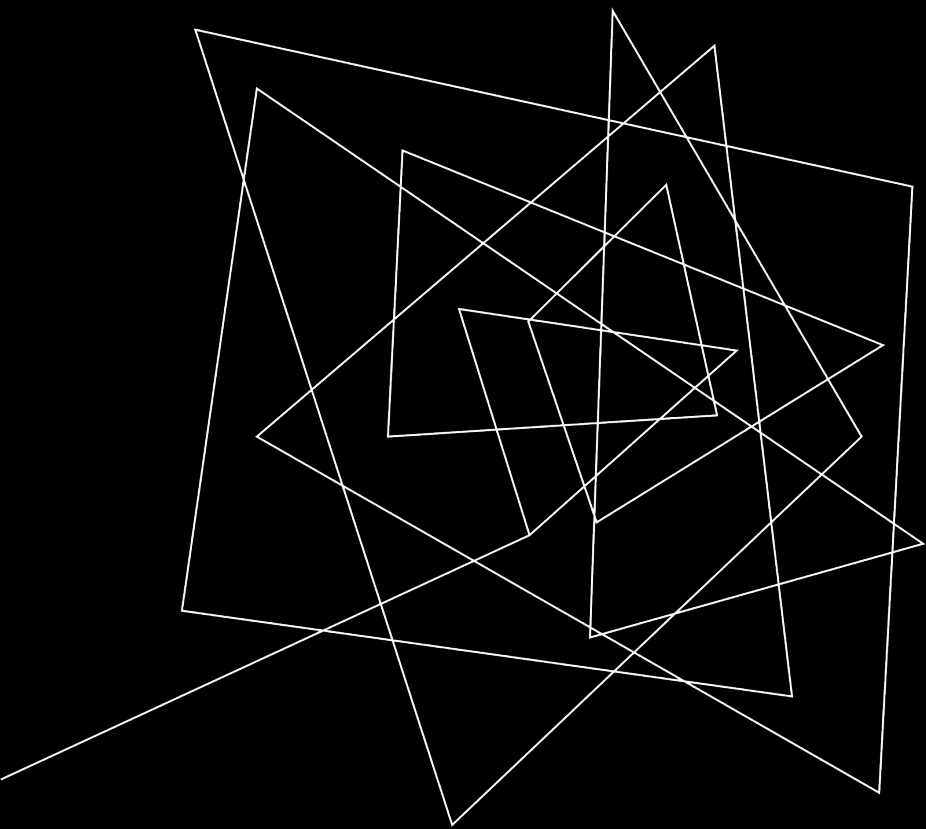
- Expenses recommendations finalized by budget committee

 - (2) Lack of resources/staffing to support ALL students including HC and those with health needs.

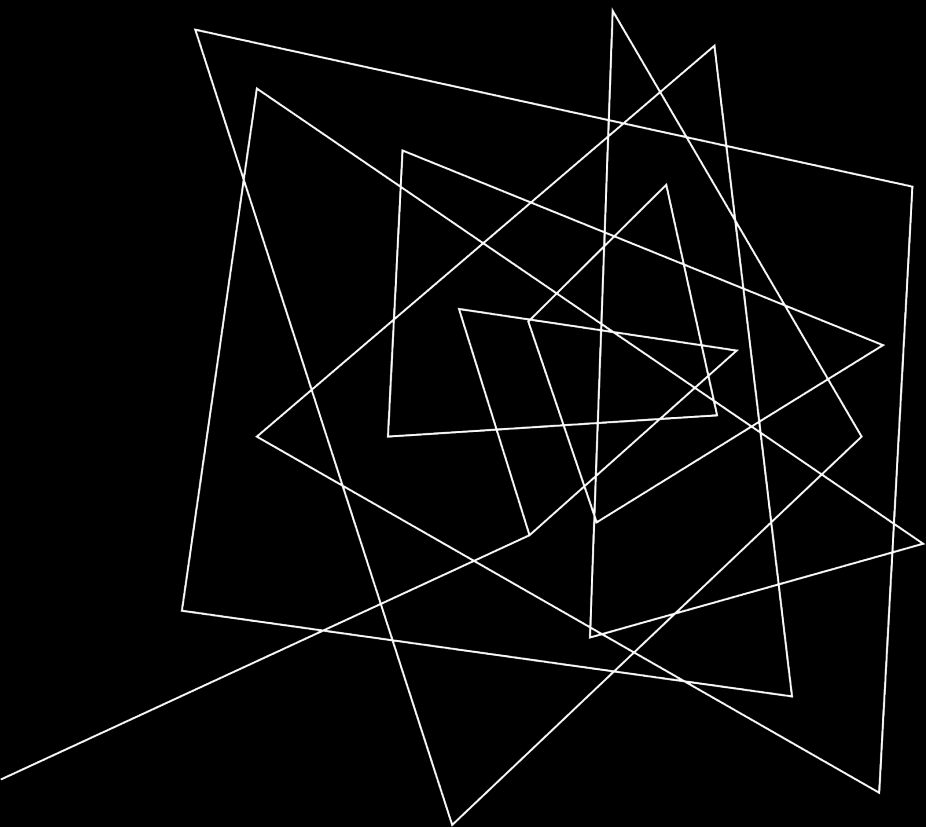


Volunteer Committee Update
